

2018-2019 ORONO LANDFILL DISPOSAL AREA RULES & REGULATIONS

The landfill, located off Forest Avenue/Taylor Road is open **Wednesday and Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.** If the scheduled day falls on a legal holiday, the landfill will usually be open on the next regular weekday during the same hours. **The landfill only accepts waste not eligible for curbside collection generated within the municipal boundaries by taxpayers.** A permit is necessary for each trip to the landfill and is based on the size of vehicle or trailer transporting the waste. Permits may be purchased at the Town Office during normal business hours. A permit doesn't expire but is only good for a one-time visit.

Only the following items will be accepted at the Landfill with a permit:

1. Wooden Boards, which may be burned. Town o
2. Demolition debris including earth, plaster, mortar, bricks, building/roofing materials, sheetrock and any similar materials. Contractors must disclose customer address at time of purchase.
3. White goods including discarded washers, humidifiers, dryers, microwaves, and stoves.
4. Small auto body parts and other sheet metal material.
5. Bulky materials such as mattresses, couches, chairs / old furniture and carpet.
6. Brush with a diameter no larger than 6" (*truck length only*), leaves and grass clippings
7. Freon "type" containing appliances including refrigerators, freezers, air-conditioners, etc., can be disposed for an **additional fee of \$20.00 per appliance.**

All materials must be separated by category, *such as:* wooden boards must be separated from metals and white goods. Roofing materials (*shingles*) must be separated from roofing boards.

Unacceptable Waste items which will be refused:

1. Refuse, regular household trash normally left for pickup, bagged clothing, fabric, etc.
2. Tires without rims (*place curbside with household trash - limit 2 per week*)
3. Branches larger than 6" diameter, trees, stumps, roots, limbs and rocks/boulders.
4. Motor vehicles, junk vehicles, larger motor vehicle parts, transmissions or engines
5. Propane tanks of any size
6. Corrugated cardboard
7. Five-gallon or larger drums or containers, unless one end is open; and clean.
8. Monitor's, PC's, TV's or Batteries /or rechargeable devices
9. **Liquid Waste** *such as;* gas, solvents, oil, resin, paint, glue, automobile fluids, insecticides, pesticides, cleaners, bio-hazard and tar products. (*Hazardous Waste Day held 2X's/year*)
10. **Solid Waste** *such as;* ash, sludge, septage, asbestos, aerosol and bio-hazard materials.
11. **Universal Waste** *such as;* Mercury containing lamps and thermostats, computer monitors, PC's, laptops and tv's, and fluorescent fixtures, ballasts, bulbs and lights. Please contact Electronics End in Brewer (207) 992-2094 for possible disposal. A fee may apply.

Curbside Collection Schedule Explained...

Trash Pickup occurs weekly on Thursday and Friday per the following schedule:

- For the streets west of Main Street, from Gardner Road to Bennoch Road, pick-up is Thursday.
- For both sides of Main Street and all streets east of Main, including everything north of the Stillwater River (*College Avenue, Webster side*), pick-up is Friday.

On the following holidays, trash pick-up is delayed by one day (*except when the holiday falls on the weekend*):
New Year's, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas.

Zero Sort recycling is a more efficient and convenient way of collecting residential recycling. Residents are no longer required to sort recycled materials for curbside collection. Materials simply need to be placed curbside in a recycling bin or otherwise clearly marked container. Materials can also be placed in clear plastic trash bags. Pine Tree Waste will be collecting recycled materials every other week, on your trash day. As always, placing your items placed curbside by 7:00 am on your collection day ensures pickup.

Boxboard, paperboard boxes, corrugated, and paper bags



PAPER

Newspaper, junk mail, envelopes, magazines, soft cover books, file folders, any color paper, cartons such as milk, egg and juice boxes



PLASTIC

All containers #1-#7, bottles, cups, jugs and empty to-go containers



GLASS

Bottles and containers (any color)



METAL

Aluminum cans, pie plates, trays, foil, tin cans, and small steel containers

plastic bags, styrofoam, paper towels, facial tissue, window glass, mirrors, light bulbs, dishes, pyrex, ceramics, recyclables containing food waste, oils, hazardous materials, needles, syringes, VCR tapes, CDs/DVDs, scrap metal, pots, or pans
